Kangaroo Care is the practice of carrying or holding a baby skin to skin with their mother or father's chest.

KangaWraps have been used to research Kangaroo Care for premature babies at birth.

### Benefits include:

- improved weight gain
- more successful breastfeeding
- shorter hospital stays
- less crying, more quiet sleep
- better temperature control
- fewer breathing problems
- closer interaction between mother and baby.

- Position your baby so that you can see its face and check its breathing regularly, especially when it is asleep. Do not sleep with your baby in the wrap

# how to wear your KangaWrap...



Place the KangaWrap across your waist with the care label in the centre



Cross over behind your back and bring over your shoulders making an X across your back



Pull both ends of the wrap through the front panel of fabric



Make an X over your front with the ends



Finish by tying the ends behind your back



If the ends are very long bring to the front and tie here

# how to carry your baby in your KangaWrap...





The front X forms the 'seat' for baby to sit securely, with each leg either side of the X



Bring your baby onto your front with its head on your chest. Slide baby's leg through one side of the X. Spread the fabric over baby's legs, back and shoulders



Slide baby's other leg through the other side of the X while supporting the upper body. Again spread the fabric over baby's legs, back and shoulder



Your baby is now sitting in the 'seat' formed by the front X



Tuck baby's legs through the front panel of fabric (with the care label)

We suggest you sit down to put your baby into the KangaWrap until you are confident

Pull the front panel up over baby's back



Make sure your baby is secure before you stand up. You may want to tighten or loosen the original knot for comfort

The front panel can also be brought over baby's feet and legs for extra warmth and protection (optional)
